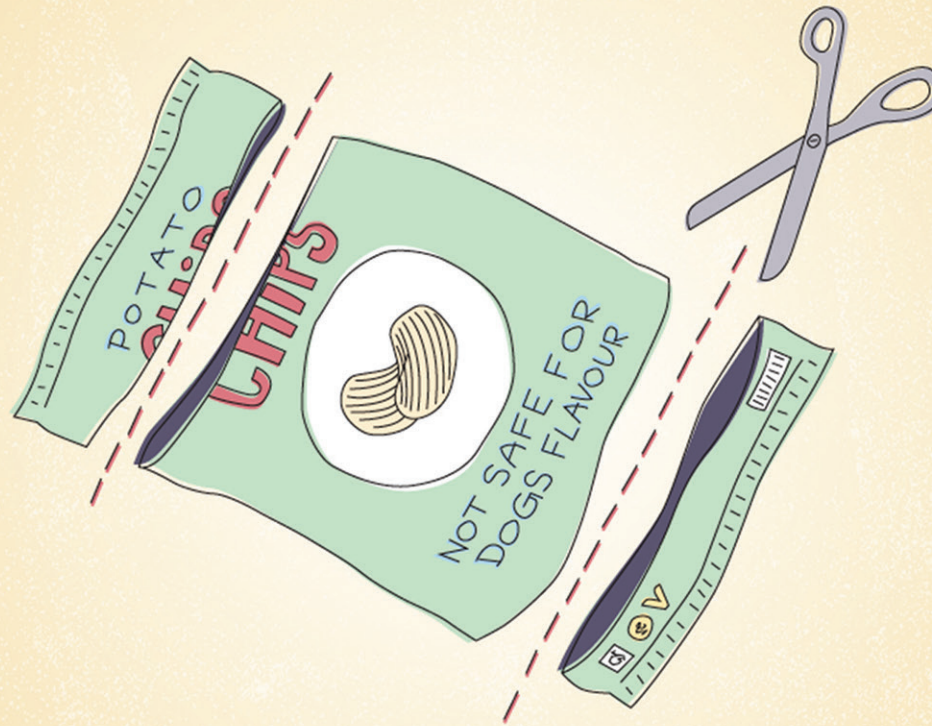

## Keep your pooch safe- Cut up all chip and food bags after use!

Chip bags and other food packaging pose serious suffocation risks to our pets. When a curious dog puts its head into the bag looking for leftover crumbs, the bag can create a vacuum-like seal around the dog's neck. Too many pets, especially dogs, have died from suffocating in chip bags, cereal boxes, pet treat bag liners, and dog food and cat food bags.
